Vehicle Donation Program

Bay Roberts Volunteer Fire Department responds to a large number of Motor vehicle emergencies each year that involve extricating drivers and passengers from vehicles after a collision. Some of which result in serious injuries, and before an accident victim(s) can be removed, fire fighters must use specialized tools and techniques to remove parts off the vehicle from around an accident victim.

Auto extrication has become an especially specialized field. With an increased use of lightweight vehicle components, airbags, computer controlled security and the introduction of hybrid systems; it is now crucial that fire fighters stay up to date in the many changes in both vehicle designs and in extrication techniques.

As part of Bay Roberts Volunteer Fire Department training program, fire fighters take part in ongoing practice sessions on scraped vehicles, usually donated or obtained from the residents of the community and surrounding areas.

Anyone wishing to donate a vehicle can do so by calling (709) 786-6951. If the vehicle is operable, you can contact any member of the fire dept and they will arrange for the removal of this vehicle. It can be driven directly to the training grounds, if not we can come and pick it up.
